

A Local Law: Village Ordinance- Traffic Regulations.

Be it enacted by the: Board of Trustees of the Village of: Cassadaga as Follows:

Limitation of Speed

Section 1. No person shall operate a motor vehicle or motor cycle upon any public highway within the corporate limits of the Village of Cassadaga at a rate of speed in excess of twenty- five miles per hour, except as specified in Section 2 of this ordinance. This section shall not apply to ambulances, fire vehicles or police vehicles when on emergency trips.

Special Speed

Section 2. No vehicle shall be operated on the following streets at a rate of speed in excess of 20 miles per hour: Park Avenue, Mill Street, North Shore Park, Pennington Road, Lakeview Avenue, Pettit Place. This section shall not apply to ambulances, fire vehicles or police vehicles when on emergency trips.

Prohibition of All Night Parking

Section 3. No vehicles shall be parked on any public highway within the corporate limits of the Village of Cassadaga between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. during the period beginning November 1 and ending March 31 of each year.

Parallel Parking

Section 4. No vehicle shall be parked on any street other than parallel with the edge of the street, headed in the direction of traffic.

Prohibition of Parking in Designated Locations

Section 5. The parking of vehicles in any of the following locations is hereby prohibited:

(A) Within twenty feet of the cross walk at the following locations: Main Street and Maple Avenue intersection, and the main Street and High Street intersection.

Stop Streets

Section 6. Main Street is hereby designated as a main artery of travel and all vehicles approaching said main artery of travel from the following streets shall, before entering the main artery, come to a full stop, unless otherwise directed by a peace officer or signal:

- (1) Mill Street
- (2) Maple Avenue
- (3) High Street
- (4) Dale Drive
- (5) Bard Road

Maple Avenue id hereby designated as a main artery of travel and all vehicles approaching said main artery of travel from the following streets shall, before entering the main artery come to a full stop, unless otherwise directed by a peace officer or signal:

- (1) Park Avenue
- (2) Mill Street
- (3) Lakeview Avenue
- (4) Pettit Place
- (5) Miller Place
- (6) Burnham Place
- (7) Commercial Street
- (8) Putnam Road
- (9) Frisbee Road

Dale Drive is hereby designated as a main artery of travel and all vehicles approaching said main artery of travel from the following streets shall, before entering the main artery, come to a full stop, unless otherwise directed by a peace officer or signal:

- (1) Park Avenue
- (2) North Shore Park
- (3) Pennington Road

Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Section 7. All ordinances of parts of ordinances of the Village of Cassadaga inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed: provided, however, that such repeal shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other respects this ordinance shall be in addition to other ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this ordinance.

Penalty for Speeding Violations

Section 8. Any person violating any of the provisions of Sections 1 or 2 of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punishable by a fine of not to exceed one hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not to exceed thirty days or both such fine and imprisonment.

Penalty for Other Violations

Section 9. Any person violating any of the provisions of Sections 3,4,5, and 6 of this ordinance shall be punishable for the first offense by a fine of not to exceed ten dollars, and for the second offense by a fine of not less than ten dollars or more than twenty – five dollars or by imprisonment for not less than two or more than fifteen days. The third or any subsequent offense within one year shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.
