

A Local Law: FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION AMENDMENT as authorized by the New York State Constitution, Article IX, Section 2, and Environmental Conservation Law, Article 36.

Be it enacted by the: Village Board of the Village of: Cassadaga as Follows:

LOCAL LAW 3 FOR THE YEAR 1987
A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 3.2 OF LOCAL LAW 2 OF 1987 VILLAGE OF CASSADAGA

Section 3.2 Shall be amended to read as follows:

3.2 BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD

The areas of special flood hazard identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency in a scientific and engineering report entitled “The Flood Insurance Study for the Village of Cassadaga, of Chautauqua County, New York”, dated December 1, 1987 with accompanying Flood Insurance Rate Maps and Flood Boundary-Floodway Maps is hereby adopted and declared to be a part of this Local Law. The Flood Insurance Study and Maps are on File at the Village of Cassadaga.
